

To access AIB's Online Research Library

1. Send request for Zotero Login credentials using the contact form on the right of the webpage.
2. Once you have received your username and password, go to zotero.org and login.
3. You will receive an invitation email to join the AIB Group Library. Accept the invitation.
4. Once logged in, go to the Groups Tab and click on Group Library. Here you will be able to search articles by topic, author, or publication. You will have access to the abstract for quick referencing or you may print the PDF of the article. Research articles are updates monthly.

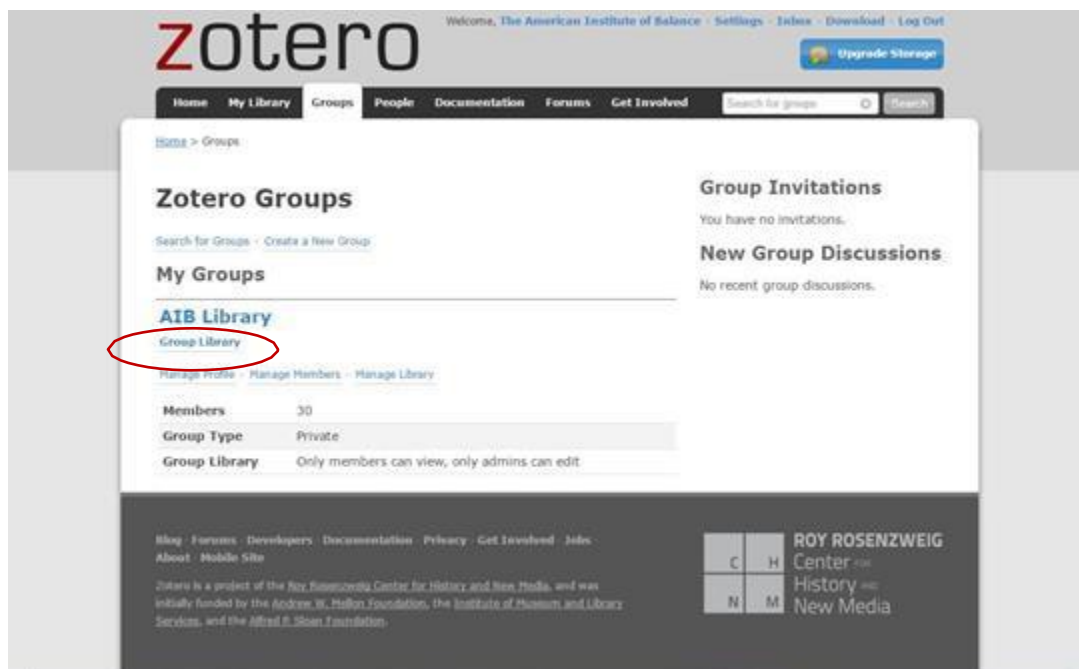
